Item 7 on the agenda was to discuss and approve updated WSPSD leak adjustment policy. Chairman Jenkins moved to approve the updated WSPSD leak adjustment policy with Director Johnson to second, the motion passed unanimously.

Item 8 on the agenda was to discuss and approve new 3 year contract for Water and Sewer with Coolfont Mountainside Association. Chairman Jenkins moved to table this until September board meeting with Director Johnson to second, the motion passed unanimously.
